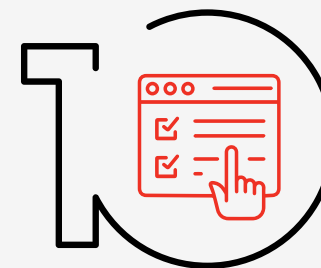

New applicants should first submit the programme admission application online before applying for financial aid.

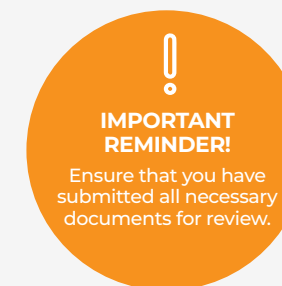


Tips for Interview:

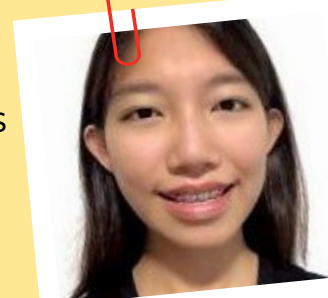
