

SUSS-SOCIAL RESILIENCE ENHANCEMENT FUND SPONSORSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The sponsorship is open to students from the **Master of Counselling and Master of Social Work** programmes.
- 2. Applicants must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents with good academic and cocurricular activities record, possess strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 3. The value of sponsorship is capped at S\$10,000 per award/recipient.
- 4. Sponsorship recipients are not required to serve a bond with Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).
- 5. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the programme. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the sponsorship.
- 6. Prospective students must separately submit the online Admission Application with supporting documents and S\$64.20 (inclusive of GST) application fee (non-refundable) to the University.
- 7. The sponsorship may not, without the prior approval of the SUSS, be held concurrently with any other awards.
- 8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the programme. In addition, the recipient must maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.0 for the continuation of the sponsorship award.
- 9. SUSS reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the sponsorship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
- 10. SUSS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the sponsorship award at its sole discretion.
- 11. Applicants are required to submit copies of educational certificates, transcripts, pay slip and other supporting documents together with the sponsorship application. Otherwise, the application would be considered as incomplete and will not be processed.



- 12. Sponsorship application is open in **July semester** and must be submitted to the University by **31 March**.
- 13. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the sponsorship award.
- 14. Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend an interview by **end April**. **The decision of the University on the selection of sponsorship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained**.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
