Refer to the curriculum plan for more details. **Students may embark on second major or first/second minor courses earliest from the second semester onwards, by declaring their choice of second major or first/second minor before course registration.**

² Students are encouraged to complete 60cu of SUSS Core in the first two years of their candidature across 4 regular semesters and 2 special semesters. Students may also consider taking available short courses in the special semester, if they wish to spread out the credit load from regular semesters.

³ HBC101 is the required School core course under the SUSS core category.

Health, Performance and Well-being - PSY265*, PSY361, PSY369 (July Semester) and PSY371, PSY373, PSY375 (January Semester)

Forensic Psychology - PSY207, PSY361, PSY376, PSY379 (July Semester) and PSY354, PSY378 (January Semester)

General Track - Choose any six level 2 or level 3 courses from the specialisation tracks or the applied psychology minors.
