When travel restrictions are lifted, students can opt to take the overseas teambuilding ETB instead. Students are advised to complete ETB in their first year.

FTPSS students should also take OEL313 which will take up 5cu of Unrestricted elective. (NIE351 has replaced OEL313, students who have not taken OEL313 should take NIE351 in lieu.)

When travel restrictions are lifted, students can opt to take the overseas teambuilding ETB instead. Students are advised to complete ETB in their first year.

For FTPSS, it is recommended to take at least 5-10 cu Unrestricted elective in Year 1 Jan semester, as that semester is comparatively lighter load than future semesters.

FTPSS students should also take OEL313 which will take up 5cu of Unrestricted elective. (NIE351 has replaced OEL313, students who have not taken OEL313 should take NIE351 in lieu.)
