

## SCCCF - SUSS SCHOLARSHIP (FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATES)

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. The SCCCF SUSS Scholarship is open to full-time undergraduates proceeding to Year 2 of their studies.
- 2. Applicants must be Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents with CGPA of 4.0 at point of application, have good co-curricular activities records, possess ability to converse well in both Mandarin and English languages, and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 3. Preference will be given to students with financial need or are involved in community projects in key areas of need within or beyond SUSS.
- 4. This Scholarship is valued at S\$15,000 per annum for up to 3 years (up to a total of \$45,000) and will be used to offset the recipient's tuition fees.
- 5. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with the University.
- 6. Recipients may not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, award or allowance without prior approval from the University.
- 7. Recipients are required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the respective programme. In addition, scholars must have good conduct and **maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.0**.
- 8. Recipients will be required to take part in university's activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.
- 9. Recipients are strongly encouraged to attend and/or volunteer at events and ceremonies organised by the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry.
- 10. Recipients will receive a free Associate Student Membership of the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry in the year of award of the Scholarship.



- 11. Scholarship application must be submitted online by the stipulated deadline, together with all relevant supporting documents. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview. The decision of the University on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
- 12. The University reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct and/or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
- 13. The University reserves the right to amend the above terms and conditions at its sole discretion without prior notice.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful scholarship candidates.
