

TEMASEK FOUNDATION SUNBURST SCHOLARSHIP (FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATES)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Temasek Foundation Sunburst Scholarship is open to all incoming full-time undergraduates (Singapore Citizens and International Students from ASEAN member countries).
- Applicants must have good academic and co-curricular activities records, active
 participation in community service, possess strong language skills, and demonstrate
 leadership qualities.
- This Scholarship will support recipients during their 4-year study at SUSS.
- Each award is valued at S\$8,000 per year (offset against recipient's tuition fees) and S\$5,000 per year (provided as allowance) for Singapore Citizen students, and S\$18,800 per year (offset against recipient's tuition fees) and S\$6,000 per year (provided as allowance) for International Students from ASEAN member countries.
- Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with the University. They may
 not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, award or allowance without
 prior approval from the University.
- Recipients are required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the
 prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the
 respective programme.
- Recipients are required to achieve 60 hours of community service throughout the tenure of the scholarship, and/or participated in 3 sustainability/community projects/programmes including one Temasek Foundation-supported youth programme.
- Recipients are encouraged to join the Temasek Foundation Youth Alumni network and be involved in the Foundation's physical/virtual engagements.
- Recipients are expected to take part in the university's activities, events and community engagement projects that showcase their motivations as wellrounded individuals, with an interest in contributing to society.
- Recipients are expected to uphold excellent conduct, excel in academic performance and lead and/or participate in non-academic programmes actively. The University reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct and/or performance has not been satisfactory.



- If the recipient decides to withdraw from the University and/or terminate the scholarship
 prematurely, the University reserves the right to impose repayment of all scholarship
 monies disbursed to the student. For continued yearly disbursement, the recipient must
 maintain a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 4.0 in each
 semester.
- Scholarship application must be submitted online by the stipulated deadline, together
 with all relevant supporting documents. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend
 an interview. The decision of the University on the selection of scholarship
 candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
- The University reserves the right to amend the above terms and conditions at its sole discretion without prior notice.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful scholarship candidates.
