

TAN HEE JOEK SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Tan Hee Joek Scholarship is open to all Bachelor of Laws (LLB) and Juris Doctor (JD) students.
- 2. Applicants must be Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents with impressive academic and co-curricular activities records, strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 3. Applicant should have a monthly household per capita (PCI) income of no more than \$\$4,300.
- 4. The value of each scholarship is S\$7,500 and will be used within the awarded academic year (2 semesters) to offset the recipient's tuition fees.
- 5. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with SUSS but are expected to make satisfactory academic progress.
- 6. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the scholarship.
- 7. The scholarships are accorded on a yearly basis. Applicants may apply for the scholarship in the academic year that they are in need.
- 8. The scholarship may not, without the prior approval of the University, be held concurrently with any other awards.
- 9. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the applied course of study. Prospective students must separately submit the online Admission application to SUSS and must be accepted before being awarded the scholarship.
- 10. Applicants are required to submit all relevant supporting documents together with the scholarship e-application. Otherwise, the application would be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
- 11. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview by end October.
- 12. The University reserves the right to revoke the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.

- 13. The University reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the scholarship at its sole discretion without prior notice.
- 14. The decision of SUSS on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
